About Cookies and how we use them

By using the LigaUltras website you consent to our use of cookies. Here you can find out more about how we use them.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small files placed on your computer's hard drive or in your browser memory when you visit a website.

What cookies do?

Cookies help to make the interaction between users and websites faster and easier. For example, they can remember your preferences, login details or information you supply as you move through an application process. What cookies don't do is store any personal or confidential information about you.

Are cookies safe?

Yes, cookies are small text files. They can't look into your computer or read any personal information or other material on your hard drive. Cookies can't carry viruses or install anything harmful on your computer.

Why should I keep cookies switched on?

We would like you to keep cookies active on your computer during your visits to our website because parts of the site rely on them to work properly. You may have the option to disable cookies by changing the options in your browser to stop accepting cookies or to prompt you before accepting a cookie from the pages you visit. If you do not accept cookies, however, you may not be able to view or use all portions of our Services due to limited functionality.

Remember, our cookies are completely safe and do not store any personal or confidential information about you.

What do our cookies do?

Cookies are important for things like match influence – for example they'll remember the influence you added in a match and make sure they stay there until the match finishes.

We also use cookies to help us **understand how our users use our website**, for example the pages users visit and the links they click on. This helps us make improvements and understand what visitors to our site are interested in.

The types of cookies we use

Like most large websites, LigaUltras uses session cookies and persistent cookies. Neither session cookies nor persistent cookies collect any personally identifiable information.

Session cookies

We use session cookies, which last only for the duration of your visit (your 'session') and are deleted when you close your browser. These simply enable us to identify that the same person is moving

from page to page.

Without session cookies many user functions on our website would not work. So, to make sure things run smoothly while you are using our website, a unique ID will track your session from page to page.

Persistent cookies

We also use certain cookies that are persistent. These remain on your computer after you have visited our site, meaning the site can remember your settings when you revisit us.

Persistent cookies help our website remember your settings when you revisit us. For example, when you are placing a bet in Betting page, we record your choice so that next time when you log in, you will not have to place that bet again.

Persistent cookies last for a pre-defined period unless they are deleted.

Third party cookies

From time to time we may also embed external content from other third party websites within our website. These include sites such as Facebook, whose cookie usage policy you can view on their own website.

We use a combination of first and third party cookies on our website.

Third party cookies are simply those that come from external partners and include social media integration (e.g Facebook), and website analytics (e.g Google).

The information that we collect and share is anonymous and not personally identifiable. It does not contain your name, address, telephone number, or email address.

This website uses cookies to analyse and to make have statistics on who visit this site. This files are:

 are from Google Analytics, a service of Web statistics. It generates an anonymously user ID which
 is used to save the visits an user make on the Website. Also they save the first and the last visit in
 Site. It also calculates when the connexion session finished, the origin of an user and keywords
 used on Google to reach the Site.
- liga_ultras It is used to keep the track of session for an user. It's a persistent cookie that lasts 2 hours.
- lang It is used to save the language selected by an user on interface. It's a persistent cookie that lasts 30 days.
- fb session It's used to detect multiple account abuses.

Turning cookies on or off in your browser

You have a number of options when it comes to receiving cookies. You can set your browser either to reject all cookies, to allow only 'trusted' sites to send them, or to accept only those cookies from websites you are currently using. We recommend that you don't block all cookies because parts of our website rely on them to work properly.
